		Are they able to assess whether or not food is safe to eat? (ie: has it gone bad?)

		Are they able to keep up with their laundry and complete the task easily?
		When the phone rings, are they able to retrieve it and engage in conversation easily with the caller?

		Can they safely connect with friends or loved ones? (ex: activities, going out to eat, religious services)
		Do they complete acticies on their own with little to no assistance? (ex: gardening, puzzles, arts & crafts etc.)
		Can they comfortably and safely care for their pets?
		Are they able to keep their primary living spaces clean and tidy? (living room, bedroom, bathroom)
		Are they comfortable attending their medical appointments and managing their health on their own?
		Do they require assistance during walking, showering or standing up so that they do not fall?
